

## LAKESIDE STADIUM

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

For the comfort and safety of all customers, staff and participants and/or pursuant to Lakeside Stadium (“LAKESIDE”) regulations and the Major Sporting Events Act 2009 (VIC), all entrants agree to abide by the following conditions of entry:

1. All entrants enter LAKESIDE at their own risk, the State Sport Centre’s Trust (“SSCT”) will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage suffered by any person entering LAKESIDE (including liability for any injury, loss or damage caused by the negligence of the SSCT or its employees or agents).
2. There are specific conditions of use which apply to facilities throughout LAKESIDE, you are required to read and abide by these conditions which are located at different facilities throughout LAKESIDE. This includes sportswear, shoes, and equipment related to the Rekortan track and Turf areas. Spike length must be 7mm.
3. Children under the age of 10 years will not be admitted to these premises unless that child is in the care of a person who is 16 years of age or more participating in a structure program at LAKESIDE.
4. No person is to cause, suffer or permit rough behaviour or harassment of other persons in LAKESIDE.
5. Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted and are prohibited from using the facilities at LAKESIDE.
6. The SSCT reserves the right to refuse entry to any person or remove any person from the premises.
7. Alcohol and glass containers are not to be brought into LAKESIDE.
8. Whilst in LAKESIDE you are responsible for your own property. Patrons are advised not to leave bags unattended for any period of time.
9. Security cameras operate within LAKESIDE, patrons may be filmed.
10. Smoking is not permitted within the LAKESIDE site.
11. Patrons causing a disturbance or refusing to comply with requests from LAKESIDE, SSCT staff or their representatives (including Security Officers) may be evicted from LAKESIDE.
12. For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all customers, staff and event participants and/or pursuant to LAKESIDE regulations and the

MAJOR SPORTING EVENTS ACT 2009 (VIC), THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED AT LAKESIDE:

- \* Alcohol
- \* Opened soft drink containers
- \* Spiked shoes that do not meet the IAAF Standard (spike length must be 7mm)
- \* Glass / Cans
- \* Musical Instruments
- \* Whistles
- \* Torn- up paper, Confetti, Crepe Paper
- \* Animals (guide and hearing animals may enter)
- \* Chairs / Stools
- \* Flags with handles exceeding 1.6 meters
- \* Flares
- \* Fireworks
- \* Laser lights
- \* Bicycles
- \* Roller Blades (can be brought in, not worn)
- \* Skateboards (can be brought in, not worn)
- \* Scooters (can be brought in, not worn)
- \* Any large article that cannot be placed under a seat
- \* Any device/s that in the opinion of the SSCT has potential to cause injury or public nuisance
